Eric Snow is a current Teton County Sheriff's Office patrol deputy and the Republican nominee for the 2026 Sheriff's race. He lives in Alta with his wife and their three young children.

Eric brings both frontline law enforcement and private sector experience, and a background in clear public communication to the race. Before joining the Sheriff's Office in April 2022, he worked in media and sales, including roles supporting major technology and defence organizations.

During his time with TCSO, he received the Governor's DUI Award for his outstanding contributions to roadway safety and DUI enforcement in Wyoming. He is also a certified Drug Recognition Expert (D.R.E.), Emergency Vehicle Operations (E.V.O.) and Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (S.F.S.T.) instructor.

Eric is running to keep the Sheriff's Office focused on public safety, professional law enforcement, and service to the people of Teton County - without political bias.

Key Positions

Public Safety & Rule of Law

Eric supports consistent enforcement of federal and Wyoming rule of law and practical policies that keep Teton County safe for residents and visitors. In particular, he advocates for practical solutions to improve safety on Teton Pass, a critical corridor that has seen multiple serious and fatal crashes in recent years.

Immigration Enforcement

Eric supports legal immigration and the continued practice of honoring ICE detainers for individuals already in custody. This approach is consistent with Wyoming law and the practice of most counties across the state. Under W.S. 31-7-143, Wyoming deems certain out-of-state driver's licenses and nonresident operating privileges invalid when issued to unauthorized aliens or without proof of lawful presence, which supports referral of commercial drivers in those circumstances to ICE when appropriate.

Drug Enforcement

Eric recognizes that drug activity in Teton County is more significant than many residents realize. He supports continued proactive investigation and interdiction by the Sheriff's Office.

Communication & Transparency

Eric believes the Sheriff's Office can and should communicate more proactively, clearly and consistently with the public about its work and priorities. He believes the Sheriff's Office should uphold the highest professional standards – free of politics.
